The 26 participants of the Forum have been selected according to the criteria set out in the Green paper and the report on the results of the open consultation, both of which you can find at

As stated in the Green paper "A Civil Society Forum would be a broad platform for a structured dialogue, but at the same time membership needs to be limited for it to be manageable and yield operational results. The object is not to create a civil society assembly as a platform for various ideologies but to create a practical instrument to support policy formulation and implementation through practical advice." In the report, the maximum size was placed to 30 participating organizations, excluding observers.
